The internship will include a paid stipend for gas if travel is required. The internship will also include college credit. You will also be required to commit 20-40 hours a month, depending on your schedule and college credit program.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

KDP interns will work directly with the Party Chair, Party Staff and elected officials in one or more of several departments, depending on your selected internship. A few roles and responsibilities include...

Communications:

- Helping with research and media tracking of Republican candidates for higher office
- Drafting letters to the editor, talking points, and op-eds, supporting the Party's earned media efforts. Monitoring and implementing the State's Letters to the Editor program.
- Assisting the Communications Director in outreach and drafting press releases.

Political Campaign and Field:

- Coordinating and executing local events with county Democratic parties.
- Assisting the Executive Director in day to day tasks.
- Organizing and expanding local grassroots field campaigns throughout Kentucky.

Digital & Data:

- Creating content for the State Parties social media accounts
- Assisting the Data Director to maintain the KDP's voter engagement tools.
- A willingness to learn VAN admin tools such as Votebuilder.
- Engaging local County Parties to assist in creating and expanding their digital presence.

SKILLS AND QUALIFICATIONS:

- The ideal candidates will be self-starters who possess sound organizational skills, pay strict attention to detail, with the ability to meet tight deadlines.
- Demonstrated interest in politics, party building and key Democratic Party issues.
- Demonstrated competency in handling several tasks, simultaneously.
