RESPONSIBILITIES:

KDP interns will work directly with the Party Chair, Party Staff and elected officials in one or more of several departments, including communications, field, digital, political and operations. There are three main internships at the Kentucky Democratic Party HQ in Frankfort.

Communications Internship:

- Helping with research and media tracking of Republican candidates for higher office
- Drafting letters to the editor, talking points, and op-eds, supporting the Party's earned media efforts. Monitoring and implementing the State's Letters to the Editor program.
- Assisting the Communications Director in outreach and drafting press releases.

Political Internship:

- Coordinating local events with town and county Democratic parties, and organizing grassroots trainings.
- Helping plan & execute State Central Committee meetings
- Assisting the Executive Director in day to day tasks.

Digital & Data Internship:

- Overseeing content creation for the State Parties Instagram account.
- Assisting the Data Director to maintain the KDP's voter engagement tools.
- A willingness to learn VAN admin tools such as Votebuilder.
- Engaging local County Parties to assist in creating and expanding their digital presence.
